Although Muskerry had the vast amount of possession over the eighty minutes, and the fact that Mallow played for 60 mins with 14 men, poor discipline ultimately cost them the game. The sin binning of Barry Jones in the first half for consistently conceding penalties reduced Muskerry to 14 men. Mallow were defending inside their own half for the majority of the first half but, Muskerry failed to transform the possession into scores and a quick tapped penalty from Mallow inside their 22 created a try in the corner just before half time. This score with an earlier penalty gave Mallow an 8-0 lead at half time.

Muskerry regrouped in the second half and an opportune try by William Healy followed by a try by Darren O'Farrell put Muskerry into the lead half way through the second half. Poor discipline by Muskerry, including the Sin-binning of full back John Herlihy allowed Mallow three kickable penalties late in the second half. Two of these penalties were converted giving Mallow a 14-10 victory.

A late on surge by Muskerry was well defended by Mallow and eventually caused the Muskerry forwards to knock on close to the line.
